# 'Trail Ride Against Cancer'

**RIDE DAY – Saturday, May 8<sup>th</sup>, 2010**

**LOCATION – Able Ranch near Lily Lake –No creeks, roads, or bridges!**

Come ride with us on our 32<sup>nd</sup> Annual 'Trail Ride Against Cancer'. The ride will be a slow pleasure ride of approximately 4-5 hours through natural lands near Lily Lake. Riders may arrive on Friday, May 7<sup>th</sup> and camp overnight in Bruno Neuville's pasture. Join us around the campfire Fri. night. If you have a musical instrument, please bring it and share your talent. Overnight camping is also available after the ride on May 8<sup>th</sup>.

**All riders must have collected donations, or make a personal donation to the Canadian Cancer Society.** The funds will be used for Public Education, Patient Services and Research. A minimum donation of \$50 for adult riders and \$25 donation for riders 14 years and under is required. In our past 31 rides, we have raised \$1,073,042.93.

*Come join us and make this the most successful year yet as we celebrate our 32<sup>nd</sup> anniversary.*

### SCHEDULE

- 8 – 10 p.m. Early registration on site, Friday May 7<sup>th</sup>. Join us at the campfire.  
8 – 10 a.m. May 8<sup>th</sup>: Registration and complimentary breakfast by Welsh's Saddlery and Western Wear  
10 a.m. Ride starts  
12:30 approx. - 1 hr break - **PACK YOUR OWN LUNCH AND WATER/JUICE.**  
Bring a halter to tie your horse to a tree. No outhouse on site. No water is being trucked in for your horse. Use the dugout there at your own risk.

4:30 p.m. approx. – Award presentations made based on amount of money turned in at the ride.

Evening Safe journey home OR visit & enjoy the campfire with friends.

You are encouraged to have your sponsorship in cheque payments to minimize work and reduce the chance of theft.

## **TRAIL RIDE RULES & OBJECTIVES**

The Alberta Trail Riding Association practises and promotes good horsemanship. The safety and well-being of all riders and horses is paramount, particularly in an event of this size. Please read the following requirements.

**Bruno Neville has graciously provided his property as a staging and camping area for the 2010 A.T.R.A. 'Trail Ride Against Cancer'. Open fires will only be allowed in the designated fire-pit. Please remain within the designated camping area and ensure that all human garbage is cleaned up before your departure! Manure and hay will be spread after the event. Your co-operation is appreciated.**

### **ABSOLUTELY NO ALCOHOL OR SMOKING ON THE TRAIL**

The minimum age for any horse entering the ride is three (3) years of age - well mannered and in **good** condition. **Do not bring a horse that shows any sign of illness, or has been in contact with ill horses. ATRA promotes good Biosecurity practices.**

All riders are required to remain behind designated group leaders.

No crowding of horses. Please leave a minimum of one horse length between you and the horse in front of you.

We encourage the full, one hour lunch break to be used as a rest period for riders and horses.

We reserve the right to request that a rider and horse be withdrawn during the ride due to poor manners or unsafe horsemanship. We also request that kickers and stallions be identified with a red ribbon on the tail. Stallions must be double tied.

The services of an on-call veterinarian will be available at the owner's expense in case of unexpected injury.

**No dogs allowed** on the trail. Dogs must be leashed in camp. The pooch is best left at home.

Horses, feed and transportation are the responsibility of the riders. Water will be available. **For biosecurity reasons, bring and use your own pails for water and feed. Do not allow your horse to drink from the trough in the yard.** Tie your horse to your trailer. A livestock manifest or current horse permit is no longer required when moving your horse.

Etiquette for riding in this natural multi-use area is to remain on the designated trail and please, no smoking or littering.

**Helmet use is recommended. Horseshoes are not required.**
