
FOESA - Annual General Meeting February 15, 2020

ATRA and the Canadian Birkebeiner Ski Festival



The 30th Canadian Birkie Ski Festival held at the Blackfoot Grazing Reserve welcomed 1,355 skiers to the Edmonton area from February 7-9, 2020. Registrants arrived from 10 Canadian provinces and territories, eight U.S. states and six other countries. Over 300 people signed up for the 55 kilometre races. The oldest skier registered for Birkie Saturday was 95 years old and the youngest, four years of age. This year ATRA hosted 2 food stations, Blackfoot 1 and Blackfoot 2; both catered skiers skiing the 55km race.



To old and new members of ATRA

A member of long standing, Harvey Nelson, has passed away on December 7, 2019 and we wish to notify the membership of his upcoming celebration of life to be held on:

April 18, 2020 - 1 pm

Mover Recreational Complex in Josephburg

Harvey was a member for many years, served on the Board for about 6 years and was President for the year 1997. At that time he was awarded a lifetime membership.

He wa actively involved with the Cancer Ride and was the top \$\$ raiser for many years.

When ATRA celebrated its 25th Cancer Ride, Harvey took first place, again, and was the recipient of the trophy saddle donated by Welsh's Saddlery.

ATRA has raised in excess of \$1,322,000 for the Cancer Society, and a sizable portion of that was generated by Harvey.

Harvey was an avid trail rider, especially in the mountains, taking his team of well trained Morgans and his wagon to pack in to the outback camps.

After his double lung transplant on July 6, 2011, Harvey was the instigator in 2012 of the fund raising rides for Second Chance, where they have raised approximately \$525,000. These funds have been dispersed to various recipients such as the Transplant Unit at U of A Hospital, providing travel and living accommodations in the U of A area for recipients and their families and the Transplant Olympics.
