From Jasper, take Hwy 93 7km south to Hwy 93A. Turn west/right and go 16km to the Moab Lake/Whirlpool Valley turnout. Turn right onto this gravel road.
In 7 km , you will see corral on left, and parking on a hill on the right, be careful with low clearance trailers. They note that rigs can park in level lot down the road, as long as they leave room for day users to park. There is an outhouse and picnic table there. Bring tools to fix/maintain corral fence.
